Safe2Tell Colorado provides students and adults, in Colorado schools and communities, an increased ability to both prevent and report violence by making ANONYMOUS reports. The 24-hour anonymous bystander tipline, staffed by professionals from the Colorado State Patrol, is available to students, parents, and communities to report any concerns regarding their safety or the safety of others.

Since 2004, Safe2Tell Colorado has received thousands of reports on issues relating to bullying, suicides, substance abuse, child abuse, planned school attacks, weapons, fights, mental health issues, and other concerning behaviors.

## How to Make a Report:

- MOBILE APP: Students, parents and community members may download the mobile app from the Apple App Store (ios) or Google Play (android) and may make a report from their smartphone.
- WEB: Reports may be submitted online by completing a secure, anonymous web report at <u>safe2tellco.org</u>by clicking "Submit a Tip."
- <u>CALL 1-877-542-7233</u>: Concerns can by given to trained Colorado State Patrol dispatchers by calling the toll-free hotline.

## Here's how it works:

- 1. The dispatcher taking the information may engage in a two-way dialogue, by sending private messages in the mobile app or web or by talking with the reporter, to gather additional information needed to fully investigate the situation.
- 2. The reporter is given a tip number and password to remain anonymous. These credentials may be used to login online and provide additional information, upload additional attachments, or view private messages.
- 3. The information is put into a Safe2Tell report which is distributed to school officials and law enforcement, if necessary.
- 4. All tips submitted to Safe2Tell CO are investigated at the local level by school safety response teams and/or law enforcement.
- 5. Outcomes are reported back to Safe2Tell CO for accountability and to ensure follow-up with each tip submitted.

The focus of Safe2Tell Colorado is early intervention and prevention. Parents are encouraged to talk to their children about this valuable resource and the seriousness of reporting concerns to Safe2Tell Colorado. The tipline is completely anonymous and does not have caller ID. Mobile app and online reports are completely anonymous and encrypted.
